PET RULES

Having a pet on DOX is not a right but a privilege, and ownership carries with it very definite responsibilities to see that pets do not become a nuisance to neighbors.

- No more than two outdoors cats per houseboat.
- No more than one dog per houseboat* - unless approved by a majority of the DOX Board. While it is required that all dogs behave when living here, pit bull and Rottweiler breeds are presumed to be inappropriate for living in our community.
- Owners or renters of all dogs wanting to come aboard are asked to complete, sign and date a DOX Pet Application available for downloading on the DOX website, and return it to a Board member before the dog takes up residence.
- We want to keep our pets safe so we ask that all dogs and cats be registered with the DOX Board so they can be added as part of the DOX Roster.
- As of February 1, 2013 all dogs visiting a DOX houseboat for more than five (5 days) a month must get PRIOR approval from a majority of the Board*. If the Board does not disapprove the dog visitation request within 7 days, it can be assumed that approval has been given.
- **Owners must pick up after their dogs and must be taken off premises to defecate and urinate.**

** An asterisk next to a rule indicates existing resident dogs and historically visiting dogs prior to February 1, 2013 are exempt.*
